The Saskatchewan Music Festival Association (SMFA), established in 1908, presented the Annual Provincial Finals Competitions and the Saskatchewan level of National Music Festival Competitions, June 1 to 3, 2018 in Saskatoon at the University of Saskatchewan.

Judges for the weekend competitions were: **Intermediate Piano:** Michael Oike, Winnipeg, MB ; **Senior/Intermediate Piano:** Thomas Yu, Calgary, AB; **Voice:** Erin Bardua, Sackville, NB; **Strings/Guitar:** Sharon Stanis, Victoria, BC; **Brass/Percussion/Woodwind:** Catherine Wood, Brandon, MB; **Musical Theatre/Speech Arts:** Donna Fletcher, Winnipeg, MB and **Choral:** Rachel Rensink-Hoff, St. Catherines, ON.

On Friday and Saturday almost 300 performances by winners from Saskatchewan's 47 District Music Festivals were heard. On Friday evening, June 1, intermediate competitors chosen from each discipline, competed in the Intermediate Grand Awards Competitions. On Saturday evening, June 2, senior competitors chosen from each discipline, competed in the Senior Grand Awards Competitions.

Prizes of over \$25,000 were awarded during the weekend's competitions, the most prestigious being the Sister Geraldine Boyle Memorial Gold Award of \$1,000 for the most outstanding performance of the Senior Grand Awards Competition. Prejudged-recorded choral winners were announced during the Grand Awards Competitions.
