Hafford and District Music Festival March 18th – 22nd, 2019

1. Our **festival dates** are **March 18th- 22nd**. The number of entries will determine the length of the festival. Please keep those dates open until details are finalized. The final program **awards night** will be **Friday, March 22nd**.
2. **Deadline** for entries is **January 28th, 2019**.
 - December 15th, 2018 is the deadline for requesting new local classes
 - Late entries will be accepted until February 3rd, with a late fee of \$10.00
 - There are two separate types of entry forms-one for Solos/Small Ensembles and one for Choirs/Large Ensembles.
3. There is a **new** syllabus! All rules and regulations are included in the **current** syllabus in the **Regulations** section. The **2019-2021 Syllabus** is available free online at www.smfa.ca/syllabus-regulations or if you need a hard copy contact Victoria Moses and she can get one for you. Please make note of the **changes and corrections** the SMFA has made to the current syllabus by clicking on the link that is found on the above mentioned webpage. You must use the **current** syllabus to make sure the class numbers and descriptions are correct.
4. **Composer of the Year** for 2019 is Christine Donkin.
5. **Trophy and Scholarship Qualifications:**
 - Participants must be 19 years or younger.
 - Participants must enter two pieces in the same discipline. For example, they must play two pieces in separate piano classes to be eligible for piano awards.
 - Participants must include at least one solo and can include a duet, trio or quartet, excluding classroom and choir entries.
6. Classes entered for **adjudication only** will receive adjudication remarks, but no mark is given and they are not eligible for scholarships or trophies.
7. An **original** or **authorized** copy of a competitor's selection must be provided to the festival committee prior to the beginning of the class. No photocopies allowed. Number the first bar of each line. Number each fifth line in Speech Arts selections.
8. Is this the **first time** you have ever **participated** in this festival as a solo or small ensemble performer? If so, please indicate this, by checking the box on the entry form.
9. All entry forms must have accurate and complete information, including all class numbers and full class descriptions. Errors could lead to entrants having to perform for adjudication only. **Illegible or incomplete forms will be returned.** If you have any questions at all, please feel free to contact Mirelle Fehr.
