

General Instruction:

ENTRY FEES: Solo Entry - \$7 per class, Duets, Trios, and Ensembles - \$4 per person
Group Entries over 3 people - \$15 per class, Provincial Classes - \$10 per entry
Choirs and Bands - \$15 per class. Classrooms - exempt from this fee.
Late Entry Fee: \$2.00 per entry.

Please indicate on the entry form for PIANO

- **Test Piece** with a **T**, Provincial **Class** with a **P**
- **Two pieces played instead of a test piece** at grade level e.g. Gr. 7 RC *t or Gr. 4 CC *t
- Indicate if an **authentic performance** of Bach, Beethoven, Chopin, Haydn, Mozart is being played in any class *
- **All Addendum Classes must be followed by (D)** e.g. 2340 Sibling Duet, Over 16 (D)

Rules for Deciding on Awards

Piano – Competitors must play either a Test Piece from the Syllabus or playing two pieces at the student's grade level from Royal Conservatory or Concord Canada. The test piece must be identified as such on the application form (T). To qualify for an award a competitor must play a test piece plus one other piece (total of 2), or two pieces from their grade level plus one other piece (total of 3). These pieces are to be identified on the entry forms *t.

Piano Distinction Award – eligible competitors must who have played in three of these categories: baroque, sonata/sonatina, 20th century (including impressionistic music, jazz, blues, or modern music), pop, romantic, accompaniment, *plus one* of either a quick study or playing at sight.

Vocal – competitors must perform a test piece plus another piece to qualify for the Distinction, Intermediate, Senior Vocal, Junior Vocal, and Primary Vocal awards.

Musical Theatre, Speech Arts & Band – Competitors must perform two pieces and be indicated on the registration form *

- Upon completion of high school students entering the Moosomin & District Music Festival will not be eligible for local awards. Students are welcome to participate in festival and would still be eligible for a provincial recommendation, but will not receive financial support.

- When choosing awards preference will be given to students within the geographic area of 80 km./50 miles.

- Awards are to be given as they are listed. The only exception is if no one qualifies to receive a specific award then it can be changed and the money awarded to someone else as the committee and the adjudicator sees fit.

- all 6-year-old and under non-competitive participants will receive a medal for each discipline they perform in.

SCHOLARSHIPS – *Open to students 12-18 in all disciplines, must be applied for and cannot win two years in a row.*

PCS Camp Award – *This award must be applied for, cannot be won two years in a row, and the recipient is chosen by the adjudicator. If you are interested in receiving this award, applications forms are available at the registration table.*
