Protocols of La Ronge and Area Music Festival

Participating in a music festival can be an enriching experience for music students. They have the opportunity to perform pieces they have worked hard to learn before an appreciative audience, and they get valuable feedback from the adjudicator. The following information is designed to assist teachers in making appropriate selections and preparing students for the festival.

Festival Dates

The 2023 La Ronge and Area Music Festival will be held March 27th to March 30th.

Registration

- 1) Registration will be done *online*. It is very important that you *accurately* fill in all information required. <https://forms.gle/chj5EpxWkcsEUSHn9>
- 2) All songs entered in the music festival must be entered by the registration date. **No late entries can be accepted and the online registration will not accept any forms after the deadline has passed. Organization of registration is done immediately upon closing and typing of the program begins immediately after. This due date is very important to the flow and organization of our program.** In general, the due date for forms is the first Thursday in February. For the 2023 Music Festival, forms should be completed by February 2nd, 2023.
- 3) When choosing classes for entry into the festival, **you must use the local syllabus**. The class number, type, name, and age group are listed. Please note that classes that are underlined are non-competitive. The Provincial Syllabus is *only* to be used if you are wanting to be eligible for provincial finals.
- 4) If you have a special entry that does not seem to fit with the syllabus, you may make a request to a committee member. This only applies if there are no possible options within the existing syllabus. This needs to be considered when selecting festival pieces.
- 5) The Programming Committee reserves the right to combine classes. You will be notified if the class you chose needs to be changed.

Music

- 1) You must provide a legal copy of the music for the adjudicator for all entries in the vocal and classical sections of the festival. You do not need to provide music for the arranged piano section.
- 2) If students or accompanists require music, they *cannot* use photocopied music. Only legal, copyrighted music can be present at the festival.
- 3) Voice competitors should arrange for live accompaniment. School groups may use recorded music.

Performer Etiquette

Teachers, please review these expectations with your students.

- 1) Performers are expected to dress in a formal fashion. Shoes are required.
- 2) Performers need to bow after a performance. It is a sign of respect to the listeners.
- 3) Performers should be coached on proper behaviour when other competitors are performing. They should listen attentively, and not, in any way, distract the performers.

Certificates & Medals

All performers will receive participation certificates. For large groups, one certificate may be provided for the group. All performers in non-competitive categories will be awarded participation medals. In competitive categories, gold, silver and bronze medals are awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator.

Scholarship Criteria

A variety of scholarships are awarded each year. These may vary according to the financial donations the festival receives and the number of competitors.

- 1) All regular scholarships and multidisciplinary scholarships are determined by the average of a participant's top 2 marks in festival. Committee members are *not* involved in determining any of these scholarships.
- 2) In order to be eligible for a regular scholarship, students must be entered in two entries in any discipline to qualify. The entries must be within the same discipline. Disciplines are considered as follows: (1) arranged piano, (2) classical piano, and (3) voice.
- 3) Multidisciplinary scholarships are available to students who enter a song into more than one of the following: arranged piano, classical piano, voice.
- 4) Canadian Composers Scholarships may be awarded to one or two deserving competitors who perform music by a Canadian composer. This scholarship is chosen by the adjudicator based on competitor marks.
- 5) Adjudicator's Choice awards are chosen by the adjudicator. There is no set criterium.
- 6) Teacher's Choice awards are chosen by the teacher and are only available to teachers who have at least 5 students in festival. There is no set criterium. If you, as a teacher, would like to award one or more \$25 scholarships to your students, speak to the Festival Committee.

Outstanding Performances Concert

The festival concludes with a concert and the presentation of scholarships. A team of festival committee members invites a limited number of participants to provide a sampling of the variety of performances heard throughout the festival. On the day of the concert, teachers may be asked to contact selected performers to confirm their attendance.
