DISTRICT/PROVINCIAL SPEECH ARTS CLASSES

All selections must be taken from published sources, except for Story Telling Solo Classes, Solo Poetry Own Composition, and Public Speaking Classes. Duplication of copyright material will not be accepted without written permission from publisher. A **Speech Arts Resource Manual** is available from the Provincial Office. This manual contains examples for most categories and ages as well as further suggested choices and their sources.

One District Winner from the **Provincial Classes 10050, 10080, 10110, 10120, or 10170**, if recommended by the adjudicator, is eligible to compete in the Provincial Finals in the **Senior Speech Arts Scholarship** category.

One District Winner from the **Provincial Classes 10051, 10081, 10111, 10121, or 10171,** if recommended by the adjudicator, is eligible to compete in the Provincial Finals in the **Intermediate Speech Arts Scholarship** category.

For **Senior** and **Intermediate** Provincial Speech Arts Classes, competitors will perform a continuous memorized program of three or more selections connected by theme, using a variety of solo scene, prose, and poetry, including the piece on which they were recommended at their District Festival. The performance will include introductions before and between selections as needed to create a unified performance. The complete program, including introductions and transitional passages, must not exceed the time limit of 15 minutes for Intermediate and 20 minutes for Senior. Sets and costumes are not required but, if used, should be minimal and must not detract from the flow of the performance.
