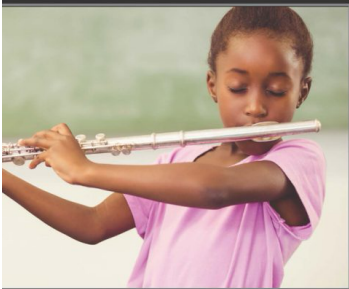

Welcome!

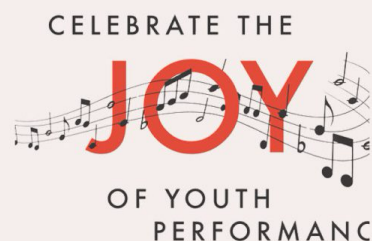
As hundreds of people from all around the province plan for 2025 music festivals, I hope for these things:

Adjudicator: Spencer McKnight

Tenor Spencer McKnight's has been described as "one of the finest tenor voices" in Canada.

McKnight began singing at the age of 17. He was encouraged to pursue music by an adjudicator who heard him sing at his local music festival. His passion for music finds him frequently immersed in the music of Handel, Rossini, and Britten.

Spencer has garnered much attention both in concert and in competition over the course of the last six years, including multiple awards at a national level, and the 2018 winner of the Gordon C. Wallis Opera Competition. Though early in his career, Spencer has had the opportunity to sing a wealth of oratorio repertoire, and had recent engagements with the Regina and Saskatoon Symphony Orchestras.

Spencer's recently toured with a recital program entitled Songs of the Great War. An artistic project many years in the making, the recital featured songs, both popular and art, from the World War One era, including the Canadian premieres of two songs by composer William Dennis Browne.

Some of the exciting upcoming engagements include the role of Don Ottavio in Mozart's Don Giovanni in Italy summer 2019, and the North American premiere of Rebecca Dale's Materna Requiem with the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra. In 2020 Spencer will join his long time collaborator Mark Turner in a tour of a new recital programme.

McKnight studied with teacher and mentor Lisa Hornung for many years, he now studies with Toronto based vocal pedagogue Mark Daboll.

His voice is described as fresh and brassy with stratospheric high notes, Spencer is proud to be a recipient of funding from the Saskatchewan Arts Board.

Adjudicator: Dr. Mark Tse

Dr. Mark Tse is a Canadian conductor and educator, serving as Assistant Professor of Instrumental Music Education at the University of Saskatchewan, and a settler living on the Treaty Six Territory and the Homeland of the Métis. He conducts the University's Symphony Orchestra and is an instructor of conducting, instrumental music teaching in secondary schools, and guitar pedagogy.

Dr. Tse values kindness, collectivism, and continuous learning. He is dedicated to co-creating opportunities for everyone to access and cultivate the joy of music, which includes musicians, conductors, composers and audiences, as well as people and genres who have historically been marginalized from orchestral music.

In the 2016 American Prize competition, he won 3rd place for Community Band Wind Ensemble Conducting and an Honourable Mention for College/University Wind Ensemble Conducting. In 2015, he won 2nd place for College/University Wind Ensemble Conducting.



His formal training led him to a Bachelor's at Oberlin Conservatory under Angela Cheng, a Master's at Université de Montréal with Jimmy Brière, and a Doctorate in Piano Performance and Musicology with Dr. Ning Lu from the University of Utah, where he also taught.

Daniel has received numerous awards, including the President's Full Scholarships at Oberlin, Montreal, and Utah, and top prizes from the San Jose International Piano Competition and the Livorno International Piano Competition.



A sought-after soloist and chamber musician, he has performed with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, La Orquesta Sinfónica de San Luis Potosí (Mexico) and the Toronto Canadian Sinfonietta, gracing stages such as the Kennedy Center, Washington; Glenn Gould Studio, Toronto and international festivals. Daniel is the

youngest artist ever invited to the Virtuosi Concert Series and collaborates with leading ensembles like the Penderecki String Quartet and James Ehnes.

He is the co-artistic director of the Clear Lake Chamber Music Festival and academic staff at Brandon University's School of Music.
