

Scholarships and Awards, revised June 2026

Maple Creek District Music Festival

Scholarships available in each discipline:

- 9 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$50 each.
- 11 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$75 each.
- 13 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$100 each.
- 15 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$125 each.
- 17 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$150 each.
- 28 years and under: up to two scholarships of \$200 each.
- Saskatchewan scholarship in discipline: up to two scholarships of \$50 each, for excellence in a performance of a work by a Saskatchewan composer or author
- Ensemble scholarships in each discipline: up to one scholarship of \$50, or one of \$100, one of \$150.
- Open adjudicator choice in each discipline: \$100 total for the adjudicator to award as they see fit to one or more participants who have performed in two or more classes in that discipline.
- Provincial bonus scholarship: \$100 to each student who performs at provincial finals, to be paid after provincial finals.

Guidelines for scholarships:

- Adjudicators are reminded that we have a small festival with few entries, and that not all these scholarships need to be given. These should be considered as the categories that may be given, and as the maximum number that may be given. Please only give scholarships and awards where they are well deserved.
- These are non-transferable. The cash from an unused scholarship can't be used for a different category.
- Students MUST perform in two solo classes in the discipline in which they are receiving a solo scholarship or award. (This does not apply to ensemble awards.)

Excellence Awards:

- Plaque + \$150 for excellence in each discipline: Piano, Singing, Musical Theatre, Speech Arts (Spoken Word), Band (solo instrument) Instrumental (any instrument other than band or piano)

Guidelines for Excellence Awards:

- These may be won by students performing grade 7 RCM/CC level repertoire or higher.
- One student may not win a particular award more than three times.
- If the award is presented to two students, each receives the full amount of money.
- Ours is a small festival, awards will only be given when it is deemed by the adjudicator that there is an appropriate recipient.

Outstanding Performer Award:

- This is a trophy given to a student or students who win two or more of the Excellence Awards, and has no monetary value.
